FOP Scholarship Application
Cover letter

The Fraternal Order of Police – Lodge #69 is proud to be able to offer student scholarships. Scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors from a Clinton County School to support continuing their education. The number and amount of scholarships awarded will depend on the funds available and number of applicants.

THE SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE STRESSES THAT EACH APPLICATION MUST:

1. Be postmarked no later than May 11th 2013
2. Be returned to the “Frankfort FOP – Lodge #69” at 201 West Washington St. Frankfort, IN 46041
3. Be signed by a Parent of the applicant
4. The outside envelope should be marked “Student Scholarship Application”
5. Application should be fully completed.
6. Application should be completed on the 2013 forms
7. Submit an official transcript of cumulative grade point average.
8. Submit an official SAT Composite Score or ACT Composite Score

The Frankfort FOP Scholarship Committee will meet and notify finalist of an informal meeting to be evaluated for further consideration. At the completion of the informal meetings, the Scholarship Committee will notify the recipient of each scholarship.

Scholarship recipients are responsible for getting the attending institution’s name and proof of enrollment to the Frankfort FOP President, Scott Shoemaker, so the scholarships can be forwarded in a timely manner. President Shoemaker can be contacted by mail at 201 West Washington St., Frankfort, IN 46041. President Shoemaker must receive the requested information no later than July 22nd. Failure to provide the above information by the July 22nd deadline will result in the forfeiture of the scholarship.

*Official transcripts must have the school’s embossed seal on the transcript itself, or be placed in an envelope secured with the school’s embossed seal.

Recommendations (Not Mandatory)

These suggestions are offered in the hope that we can get all of our applicants qualified for the scholarship they seek.

1. Send the application by mail or drop it off at the Frankfort Police Department front lobby during normal business hours. This will ensure its arrival by the deadline.
2. Send the official high school transcript in the same envelope with the application, rather than have the school send it separately. This way you will ensure that both arrive together by the deadline.

**Scholarship Application for Graduating Students
2013 Application Year**

This scholarship is for the students with interest in pursuing a career in law enforcement, criminal justice or a related field. Applicants who meet the eligibility requirements may submit an application. Applications must be postmarked no later than **May 11th 2013** and returned to **FOP President Scott Shoemaker 201 West Washington St. Frankfort, IN 46041**. Please mark the outside of the envelope with **“Scholarship Application”**. Scholarships may be used at any institution of higher education to defray expenses directly related to academics to include: tuition, books, fees, and room & board.

Eligibility: The applicant must be planning and eligible to continue his/her education at an accredited institution of higher education, within the year the scholarship is awarded. The applicant must maintain a **full-time student status**. All applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of at **least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale and a minimum SAT Score of 1000 combined Math and Reading or an ACT composite score of 17. Attach official copies high school transcript, SAT composite score and/or ACT composite score.**

Criteria for Selection: The scholarship committee will consider scholastic achievement and excellence, extracurricular activities (school and community), honors, awards, and SAT or ACT score as points of consideration in the selection process. Race, color, sex, creed, religious beliefs, national origin, or physical impairments will not be considered in determining recipients.

Limitations: Any applicant shall be disqualified from receiving a scholarship if the applicant receives one or more of the following:

1. Acceptance or appointment to any of the service academies
2. A scholarship/grant that is specifically designated for full-tuition and room & board.

Applications: Each prospective recipient shall sign his/her name in the space provided on the application form and by doing so, pledges to remain in school for the full semester following scholarship’s award. The recipient further agrees to repay the Frankfort Fraternal Order of Police for the amount of the scholarship in the event that the student does not remain a full-time student for the semester immediately following the award.

3. Two letters of recommendation, excluding relatives. At least one (1) letter from a teacher, principal, or school counselor.

4. PERSONAL STATEMENT: Include a typed statement of at least 500 words, but no longer than 850 words. Put your name on each page. In the statement, you should:

- Describe why you want to go to college and three personal attributes you think will help you succeed in college;
- Describe your long-range goals and how furthering your education will assist you in reaching those goals;
- Comment on an accomplishment of which you are proud or activities in which you have been involved;
- Reflect upon any challenges you have faced and how you responded to them.

I fully understand the eligibility requirements, criteria for selection, and limitations of this scholarship. All information is correct.
