A. Request for Proposals Deadline. Proposals will be accepted by the City of Frankfort Board of Public Works and Safety (hereinafter "BOW"), 301 E. Clinton Street, Frankfort, Indiana, 46041 until 4:00 p.m. on July 14, 2025, for the creation of a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan (hereinafter "Plan"). The plan must develop a holistic, well-defined strategy to prevent roadway fatalities and serious injuries within the City of Frankfort, Indiana (hereinafter the "City"). The Plan must include all components laid out by the United States Department of Transportation (hereinafter "DOT") in the SS4A grant. Components off a SS4A action plan can be found on Table 1 in the SS4A 2022 Notice of Funding Opportunity found at https://www.transportation.gov/sites/dot.gov/files/2022-08/SS4A-NOFO-FY22-Amendment-1.pdf. The Plan must include the entire City's jurisdictional area.

C. Requirements for Letters of Interest.

- 1. Provide the firm name, address of the responsible office from which the work will be performed, and the name and email address of the contact person authorized to negotiate for the associated work.
- 2. List the firm's qualifications and experience that it has in making safety action plans or similar planning efforts.
- 3. List the project manager and other key staff members who will be working on this project, if selected. Include staff qualifications and key experience related to this project and a breakdown of the estimated percentage of work each staff member will perform.
- 4. Provide unique ways your firm will approach this project and how it will approach the safety of both pedestrians and vehicles.

- 5. Proposed schedule on when components of the Plan will be completed.
- 6. Letters of Interest (hereinafter "LOI's") shall be limited to twelve (12) pages.
- D. **Submission**. LOI's shall be submitted electronically via PDF to Kimberly Black at the following email address: kblack@frankfort-in.gov. LOI's must be received no later than 4:00 p.m. on July 14, 2025. Responses received after this deadline will not be considered.
- E. **Project Fee.** If selected, the firm will be paid through cost reimbursement with an agreed upon maximum cost.
- F. **Project Fee.** If selected, the proposed completion date for the Action Plan will be July 31, 2026.
- G. **Selection Procedures.** Consultants will be selected for work based on the evaluation of the LOI. The Consultant Selection Rating Form used to evaluate and score is included for reference. Final selection ranking will be determined by the weighted score totals with the highest score being the top ranked firm.

H. Certification Regarding Debarment, Suspension, Ineligibility, and Voluntary Exclusion.

- 1. The Consultant certifies, by submission of the proposal, that neither it nor its principal is presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, declared ineligible, or voluntarily excluded from participating in covered transactions by a Federal department or agency.
- 2. Where the Consultant is unable to certify to any of the statements in this certification, such prospective participant shall attach an explanation to this proposal.
