

COMMON COUNCIL
September 27, 2021

The Common Council met in a regular meeting on September 27, 2021, at 7:00 P.M. in the Council Chambers, 301 East Clinton Street, Frankfort, Indiana.

Mayor Judy Sheets called the meeting to order and led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon roll call, the following members were present: Mayor Judy Sheets, Brandt Fuller, Clarence Warthan, Joe Palmer, Steve Beardsley, Mike Brite, and Eric Woods. Megan Sheets was absent. Also present were Clerk-Treasurer Carol Bartley and City Attorney Les Bergum.

MINUTES: The minutes for the September 13, 2021, regular meeting were presented. Councilmember Brite made a motion to approve the minutes from the September 13, 2021 meeting, seconded by Councilmember Woods. Upon a roll call vote, five ayes were recorded. Councilmember Palmer abstained. Motion passed 5-0.

PUBLIC COMMENTS:

Treigh Rush spoke to the council regarding the lack of parking downtown for citizens of Frankfort. His residence is on Columbia Street and he asked the council to remove some of the three-hour parking signs. After a discussion, the council asked Chief Shoemaker and Deputy Chief Skinner to review the parking in the area and report back to the council.

PUBLIC HEARING ORDINANCE 21-13: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES AND FEES FOR TRASH COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE AND WASTE

Mayor Sheets called a recess of the meeting at 7:13 PM and opened a public hearing to discuss any comments or questions about the proposed changes to the trash fees. There were no comments or questions. Mayor Sheets closed the public hearing at 7:14 PM and reopened the council meeting.

Councilmember Warthan made a motion to pass ordinance 21-13 on second reading, seconded by Councilmember Palmer. Upon a roll call vote, six ayes were recorded. Motion carried 6-0.
