

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS  
SPECIAL MEETING  
June 20, 2023

The Board of Public Works and Safety met in a special meeting on June 20, 2023, at 2:30 P.M. in the Council Chamber, 301 East Clinton Street, Frankfort, Indiana.

The following action was taken: Mayor Sheets called the meeting to order. The following members were present: Mayor Judy Sheets, and Greg Miller. Also present were, Clerk-Treasurer Carol Bartley, and others, as noted in the minutes. Megan Sheets was absent.

**STREET DEPARTMENT**

The board briefly discussed the bids for the 2023 Community Crossings Grant paving projects. Mayor Sheets stated that Rieth-Riley Construction Company had the lowest bid of \$410,475.00. G. Miller made a motion to accept the bid from Rieth-Riley for the 2023 paving projects, seconded by Mayor Sheets. Upon a roll call vote, two ayes were recorded. Motion carried 3-0.

Street Department Superintendent Jason Forsythe spoke briefly to the board about a proposal from Rieth-Riley to pave the alley next to Domino's Pizza for \$13,700.00. The money for the paving of the alley will come from the funds the city has already budgeted for paving this year. G. Miller made a motion to accept the bid for the alley's paving with funds not included in the community crossings grant, seconded by Mayor Sheets. Upon a roll call vote, two ayes were recorded. Motion carried 2-0.

Mr. Forsythe presented a bid from Campos Construction to complete the replacement of the concrete at Maple Drive for \$49,776.50. Per city attorney Alicia Albertson, since the bid is under \$50,000.00 the city will not need to obtain a second bid. G. Miller made a motion to accept the bid from Campos Construction, seconded by M. Sheets. Upon a roll call vote, two ayes were recorded. Motion carried 2-0.

**POLICE DEPARTMENT**

Police Chief Scott Shoemaker asked the board to accept the retirement of Glen Talbot, with a date to be provided later. G. Miller made a motion to accept the letter of retirement from Glen Talbot, seconded by Mayor Sheets. Upon a roll call vote, two ayes were recorded. Motion carried 2-0.

Mr. Shoemaker also asked the board to accept the resignation of Caleb Thompson effective June 19, 2022. G. Miller made a motion to accept the resignation, seconded by Mayor Sheets. Upon a roll call vote, two ayes were recorded. Motion carried 2-0.

G. Miller made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by M. Sheets. Mayor Sheets adjourned the meeting at 2:45 P.M.
