**ORDINANCE NO. 12-02**

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. CO-86-20;  
ESTABLISHING THE CITY OF FRANKFORT DEPARTMENT  
OF REDEVELOPMENT; AND REESTABLISHING  
THE CITY OF FRANKFORT REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION**

**WHEREAS**, the Common Council enacted Ordinance No. CO-86-20 on October 14, 1986, wherein there was created a redevelopment commission under and in accordance with provisions of I.C. 36-7-14-1 through 36-7-14-40, which ordinance was codified as §34.05 in the City of Frankfort Code of Ordinances; and

**WHEREAS**, the original redevelopment commission has been inactive for years and the identities and terms of several of its most recent members are unknown; and

**WHEREAS**, I.C. 36-7-14-3 now requires that a municipal department of redevelopment be established to be controlled by the redevelopment commission; and I.C. 36-7-14-6.1 has been amended to also require appointment of an individual to serve as a nonvoting advisor to the redevelopment commission; and

**WHEREAS**, the Common Council has determined that Ordinance No. CO-86-20 should be repealed; that, pursuant to I.C. 36-7-14 and 36-7-25 (collectively, the "Act"), the City of Frankfort should establish a department of redevelopment and should reestablish its redevelopment commission to control said department in accordance with such statutory authorization.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF FRANKFORT, INDIANA**, as follows:

1. Ordinance No. CO-86-20, the codified text of which appears in §34.05 of the City of Frankfort Code of Ordinances, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

2. Pursuant to IC 36-7-14-3, the Council hereby establishes the City of Frankfort Department of Redevelopment (the "Department"), for the purposes and to exercise the powers set forth in the Act or otherwise granted by law. The Department will be controlled by, and the Common Council hereby reestablishes, a board of five (5) members to be known as the City of Frankfort Redevelopment Commission (the "Redevelopment Commission"), two of whom shall be appointed by the Council and three of whom shall be appointed by the Mayor of the City. Each member of the Redevelopment Commission must be at least eighteen (18) years of age, and must be a resident of the City.

3. Pursuant to IC 36-7-14-6.1, the Mayor of the City shall appoint an individual to serve as a nonvoting advisor to the Redevelopment Commission who must be a member of the school board of a school corporation that includes all or a part of the territory served by the Redevelopment Commission.

4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption in the manner provided by law.


