PUBLIC HEARING - RESOLUTION 24-13

Mayor Sheets called a recess of the meeting at 7:03 PM and opened a public hearing for Resolution 24-13. City Attorney Alicia Albertson explained Fire station lease. Mayor Sheets closed the public hearing and opened the council meeting at 7:04 PM.

RESOLUTION 24-13 APPROVAL FIRE STATION LEASE

Attorney Rich Starkey of Barnes and Thornberg, explaining the Fire Station Lease. Bonds for the new station will be issued per the timeline. Approval of the resolution will authorize the lease and accept the petition as presented. Two public hearings will be held in regard to the bond being paid by property tax dollars. The two hearings are required by statute and will be held on 11/12 and 11/13/24. Specific details as to how this affects the tax rate will included in the Notice of Public Hearing.
