



For the benefit of all participants, please comply with the following rules.

**THE CITY OF FRANKFORT, INDIANA & THE PARKS DEPARTMENT IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR INJURIES, ACCIDENTS, OR STOLEN ITEMS**

\*Sapphire Bay may be closed at any time due to weather, maintenance, or other operational concerns\*

**Guests younger than fourteen (14) years of age must be accompanied by an adult in Sapphire Bay and must remain under close adult supervision at all times. Guests eight (8) years of age or younger, or any minor who cannot swim must be within arm's reach of an adult at all times while in the water.**

Children who are not toilet trained must wear swim diapers. **DO NOT** change diapers at poolside.

The following activities and items are not permitted in Sapphire Bay:

- All persons shall take a cleansing shower before using the pool. A bather leaving the pool to use the toilet shall take another cleansing shower before returning to Sapphire Bay.
- Anyone who has an area of exposed sub epidermal tissue, open blisters, cuts, etc. is advised not to use the pool.
- Anyone who has or has had diarrhea in the past two (2) weeks shall not use Sapphire Bay.
- Spitting, spouting of water, drinking of the water, blowing the nose and similar behavior in the pool is prohibited. No gum chewing allowed.
- No running or rough play is permitted in the pool, on the runways, on floats, on platforms, in dressing rooms or in the showers. No diving permitted. No children on the shoulders of others. You are expected to follow all Lifeguard instructions.
- Street clothes are not allowed in the pool. All participants must be appropriately covered in swim attire while at Sapphire Bay. All diaper aged children shall use plastic pants with tight fitting elastic at the legs and waist, or swim diapers.
- Food may be permitted only in the spectator area of the pool. No glass containers are allowed in Sapphire Bay. No coolers or outside food allowed. Clear, unopened water bottles are permitted.
- No outside chairs, umbrellas or pop-up coverings of any kind.
- When entering the Lazy River, please use the designated entrance and exit locations. No climbing, sitting or walking on Lazy River walls.
- Guests may only use Sapphire Bay inflatable tubes while in the lazy river and designated slides.
- No dogs permitted, unless a documented service animal. Participants with service animals must show proper paperwork to enter Sapphire Bay.
- No climbing up slides, jumping from slides, participants must go down feet first, and only one participant per slide at a time.
- Smoking, smokeless tobacco, vaping, e-cigarettes are not permitted in Sapphire Bay.
- Skateboards, skates, hover boards, Razors, rollerblades, scooters, bicycles & other similar recreation equipment are not permitted at Sapphire Bay.

Participants must follow all rules while using all water slides. Rules are posted at slide entrance.

Sapphire Bay and the City of Frankfort, Indiana are not responsible for any lost, damaged, and/or stolen property.

**All other Park Rules & Policies apply**

**No refunds and no rainchecks.** If a participant's behavior affects the safety of others, or if a participant is influenced by drugs or alcohol, the participant will be escorted from Sapphire Bay and/or not allowed entry.
